Dear Parent / Carer

We are very excited to welcome you to our school Christmas Fair this Wednesday 13th December 3.30pm-5.30pm.

All children should be collected at the normal time from their usual collection points and all children attending the fair must be accompanied by an adult.

Please enter the fair through either the hall door or via the back door around the corner, at the far end of the playground (passed the Year 1 classrooms), situated next to the wall of the new hub. We will place a fair entrance sign on this door for clarity. Entrance to the fair will be at 3.30pm. Queues can be formed at either door to help to ensure swift access and to ease congestion.

We have lots of local crafts and produce on offer from local stall holders, which will be set up in the main hall, alongside our Chocolate Tombola and Christmas Raffle. Tea, coffee and hotdogs will also be available to buy at a small charge and a free uniform stall with good quality second hand uniform will be on offer. These stalls will be housed in the music room.

The children have been working incredibly hard on their own stalls which will be hosted in the classrooms. Please ensure to work your way around the whole school to visit each stall along the KS1 and KS2 (upstairs) corridors.

Santa's Grotto will be located in our new HUB based at the end of the downstairs corridor. A visit to Santa will be charged at £1.50 with a small gift for each paying child.

We also have a surprise special guest at the fair. Join us outside the school office at 3.30pm for a meet and greet photo opportunity! After that you may find him helping out down at Santa's Grotto...

Here at Hilderthorpe we understand the cost of living is affecting us all. We really hope to offer the children a festive experience without the added pressure of high expenses.

Whilst we can not guarantee what local stall holders will charge, we have made a conscious effort to keep our children's stalls and activities at a low cost, ranging from 20p - 50p.
