This Half Term

This half term our topic is 'Animals and Their Babies"

In Communication and Language we are listening to story CD's on our CD player, speaking and listening in circle times and taking part in phonics games and activities.

In Personal, Social and Emotional Development we are welcoming our new starters to Nursery, taking turns and thinking about our "Dreams and Goals" in Jigsaw.

In physical development we are going to be making patterns to music with our bodies and going to the hall for movement sessions on a Tuesday morning. We will be continuing our Dough Disco and "flipper flapper" sessions to build our arm and hand muscles ready for writing.

Our texts this half term are Farmyard Hullabaloo, Dear Zoo, The Great Pet Sale, Monkey Puzzle and our Traditional Tale of the half term is The Three Little Pigs.

In mathematics we are practising our counting skills and number songs, counting to six, comparing and measuring height, length, mass and capacity. We will be singing our weekly maths songs. These are Sing a Song of Sixpence, I am a Little Bean, 5 Cheeky Monkeys and When Goldilocks Went to the House of the Bears.

In Understanding the World we are looking for signs of Winter and comparing the changes from Autumn as we move into Spring. We will be looking at where we find animals such as jungles, zoos, pet shops and farms. We will be having special visitors into Nursery from a vet and Pets at Home so we can handle some real animals and learn how to take care of them.

In Expressive arts and design we will be exploring animal patterns, making animal masks, learning lots of animal songs and playing instruments to the Carnival of the Animals music.

We are learning to find our own names, we do this to find our coat pegs and our going home boxes. We are also making marks to represent our names. We are working hard to be independent with putting our coats on and zipping them up ourselves. Please encourage children to try this at home.

Don't Forget...

PLEASE ensure that children's personal items are named; jumpers, cardigans, coats etc.

(We have lots of children with the same coats!)

Children should be bringing a water bottle to Nursery with them so they can access drinks throughout the day. Please make sure their bottle is named so we can easily return it at the end of the day.
