#### General

Whilst the weather is beginning to become brighter, it is important that your children are dressed appropriately for school. Please bring a waterproof coat. If your child wishes to bring wellies into school, please make sure they bring a spare pair of shoes for the classroom.

**Maths** - This half-term we will continue to look at numbers to 40 before moving onto numbers to 100! We will also begin exploring multiplication and division. We will then move onto fractions and focus on the vocabulary half and quarters.

**Computing** – We will be exploring coding. We will learn to understand instructions and how to use code to plan and make our own computer programme.

**Geography** - We are looking at the Polar Regions. We will be exploring the North and South Pole and learning about the Arctic and Antarctica. We will be looking the climate, landscape and animals within each region, before comparing the Polar Regions to our lives in Bridlington.

**Science** - This half term we will be looking at materials. We will be identifying and sorting a range of materials made from different materials. We will be performing simple tests to see if different materials are waterproof or absorbent and learning that materials can bend and stretch.

**DT-** We will be exploring fruits and vegetables, identifying where plants grow and which parts we eat. We will be designing and making our own smoothies using the fruits and vegetables explored in previous lessons.

**Music** - We will be looking at Benjamin Britton and Anna Meredith and understanding how sounds, instruments and movement can be used to represent a theme or idea.
