# **HOMEWORK**

Reading is a key focus for children in Year 2 and we would appreciate it if you could read once a day with your child.

We will send home **Maths** problems to support our work in school alongside spellings and handwriting sheets for the children to practise.

### Art and Design

We will be exploring sculpture this half term. We are going to use clay to make pinch pots and design our own clay tile using different patterns.

#### Science

We are learning about how materials can change shape. We are looking at how materials can be changed from the actions of bending, squashing, twisting and stretching and link these with the materials that can be changed through those actions.
