ICT - We will be learning about Animation and linking this to our Vikings work.


HISTORY - Children will study the VIKINGS and their impact. They will learn about where they came from and why, Viking life and their towns and their longboats.

Home learning - Reading remains a key focus for children in Year 4 and we would appreciate it if you would continue to read regularly with your child. Reading books must be returned on Friday to be changed.

Children also have Log INS for Abacus and TTRockstars. Daily visits to these sites will boost their times table and maths skills ready for the multiplication check this half term.

LITERACY - We will be basing our work on the Jane Considine 'The Write Stuff' non-fiction unit 'A life Electric: Nikola Tesla.' We will also look at the Norse Myth - 'Arthur and the Golden Rope.' We will develop our sentence stacking skills, our vocabulary and writing style and build up to independent writes. Grammar, punctuation work and a spelling programme remain ongoing.
