Maths

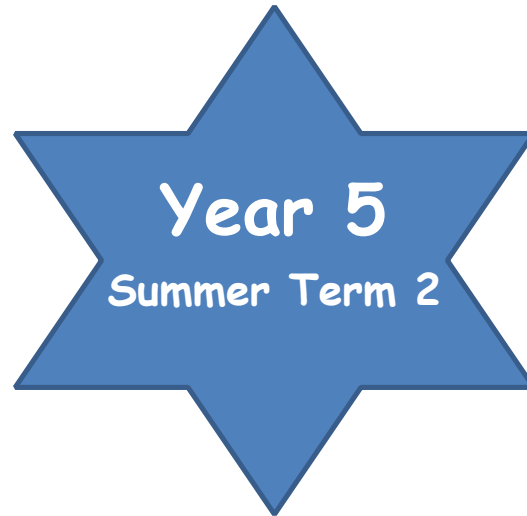
