Each half term we will send a newsletter detailing what we will be covering in the curriculum and any other important information. If you would like further details, please speak to your child's class teacher.

English

This half term, we will be writing a narrative based on the short film 'The fantastic Flying Books of Mr Lessmore' by Moonbot Studios.

We will also be writing a non chronological report about penguins.

In Guided Reading, we will be reading 'Under my Feet' and 'The King in the Car Park'.

Maths

This half term, we will be will be looking at numbers and their place value to 1 000 000 for the first couple of weeks before moving onto addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. The children will also be working on strengthening their word problem skills.

<u>French</u>


During this half-term, the children will be learning all about transportation. This will include learning vehicle names and directions.

Music

This term, the pupils will be listening to a range of Jazz music and learning about Swing music from the 1940s. Pupils will have the opportunity to learn to play a jazz piece as a class and will improvise on their chosen instrument.



Jigsaw

This unit is called 'Being me in My World.' Children will be learning about how to consider others and their feelings.

<u>PE</u>

Children need to come into school wearing their school PE kit on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. They will be learning about how to move for health in 'Body Management' and they will learn a range of bat and ball skills during 'Invasion Games'.

Topic (History)

Our topic this half term is to look at the history of the Stone Age. We will look at the importance of Stone Age discoveries and how they impacted the survival of Stone Age man, settlements and the importance of cave paintings as a form of communication.

Science

The children will be learning about Earth and Space in their Science topic this half term. In this topic, the children will develop their knowledge of the Earth's (and other planets') place in the solar system, and their relationships with other bodies in space, in particular with the Sun.

Religious Education

We will begin our unit on expressions of faith. We will look at Islam, Christianity and Judaism and compare special symbols and forms of expression.

In design and technology, we will be designing an electronic system.

We will be learning a range of word processing skills, including how to open, save, edit and export a range of documents.
