LITERACY - Our work this half term will be based around the book 'Once Upon a Raindrop'. We will start with some poetry work and then develop our explanation writing and our instruction writing skills. Guided reading will also continue as well as individual reading and Reading Plus.

SCIENCE- We will be looking at a topic called 'Electricity'. This involves learning about circuits, investigating which materials conduct electricity and creating switches.

R.E. - We will complete our unit 'Belief in the Community', focusing on the key question 'What does it mean to belong to a faith?'. Later we will look at the significance of light to Christmas and the Christian religion.
