English

Maths

Music

This half term the children will be learning all about Classical fanfare music, including 'Keep the Home Fires Burning'.

PE

Children need to come into school wearing their school PE kit on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. They will be learning about 'Interpretive Dance' and 'Invasion Games'.

Topic (History)

Our topic this half term is to look at the history of the Iron Age and understand the changes that happened from the Stone age and Bronze age. We will look at the importance of sacred locations, settlements, Iron Age religion and how these time periods have impacted modern times.

Science

We will be learning about 'Forces'. We will develop an understanding of how forces including gravitational attraction and drag forces - friction, air resistance, water resistance, and upthrust in water - affect movement.

Religious Education

We will continue our unit on expressions of faith. We will look at Islam, Christianity and Judaism and compare what peace means. We will also be taking part in our annual Remembrance workshop at Emmanuel Church.

Art and Computing

In our Art sessions, we will be focusing on art installations and using mixed media to create our own large and small installation works.

We will be learning how to create concept maps in our Computing sessions.
