We hope you have all had a lovely half term break, we are very excited for the half term ahead!

This half term our topic is 'Our Amazing Earth'.

We love to read and share books every day in school. We will be exploring language rich, exciting texts with the children such as My Friend Earth and the One Day On Our Blue Planet books including- In The Savannah, In the Antarctic and In The Rainforest. We will be exploring a range of fiction and nonfiction texts learning about Earth and how we can all help to look after our planet.

Children will continue to develop and make progress in their early literacy skills through our daily phonics sessions using our scheme- Read Write Inc. Please practise speed sounds and blending daily using the green sound book in your child's book bag alongside their blending and reading books. .

We will be continuing to develop our maths skills using Maths No Problem and Mastering Number. These are fun and exciting ways of learning which include lots of stories and hands-on activities. This half term we are focusing upon counting and we will also be starting to combine amounts for our work on addition.
