GENERAL

Whilst the weather is beginning to become brighter, it is important that your children are dressed appropriately for school. Please bring a waterproof coat. If your child wishes to bring wellies into school, please make sure they bring a spare pair of shoes for the classroom.

MATHS – This half-term we will continue to look at numbers to 40 before moving onto numbers to 100! We will also begin exploring multiplication and division. We will then move onto fractions and focus on the vocabulary half and quarters.

Computing - We will be looking at questioning. We will be creating pictograms and constructing a binary tree to answer questions..

Geography - We are looking at the Polar Regions. We will be exploring the North and South Pole and learning about the Arctic and Antarctica. We will be looking the climate, landscape and animals within each region, before comparing the Polar Regions to our lives in Bridlington.

Science – This half term we will be looking at animals (vertebrates). We will be identifying and naming a variety of common animals. We will also be exploring animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

DT- We will be exploring fruits and vegetables, identifying where plants grow and which parts we eat. We will be designing and making our own smoothies using the fruits and vegetables explored in previous lessons.

Music – We will be beginning to look and explore jazz music. We will be listening to different pieces of jazz music and look at improvising.

TOPIC

Our Topic this half term is plants. This is a theme which is also covered within other areas of the Curriculum. We will be spending time in the Jubilee Garden planting seeds and observing them as they grow.
