This Half Term

We hope you have all had a lovely half term break, we are very excited for the half term ahead!

This half term our topic is 'Superheroes'.

We love to read and share books every day. We will be exploring language rich, exciting texts with the children including Supertato, Zog and the Flying Doctor, Zippo the Superhero and nonfiction texts about doctors, firefighters, police officers and other people who help usevery day superheroes! If you have any resources that you feel will enhance our learning, please let your class teacher know.

We will be spending time exploring a new book each week. We discuss key facts about books and features including the title, the roles of the author and the illustrator, the blurb, contents pages and making predictions about events. We enjoy having conversations about the books we have read- encouraging children to make observations and give their opinions and feelings.

Children will continue to develop and make progress in their early literacy skills through our daily phonics sessions using our scheme- Read Write Inc. You can find more information about our phonics programme at www.ruthmiskin.com/en/ and click on the parents tab, here you will find lots of useful information on how you can support your child's learning at home. Please practise speed sounds daily using the little green sound book in your child's book bag. Some children now have a yellow one too- for those moving onto Set 2 Speed Sounds.

We will be continuing to develop our maths skills using Maths No Problem and Mastering Number. These are fun and exciting ways of learning which include lots of stories and hands-on activities. This half term we are learning about: counting to 20, doubling, halving and sharing, odds and evens, mass, volume and capacity and money- it is going to be a very busy and fun maths filled half-term!
